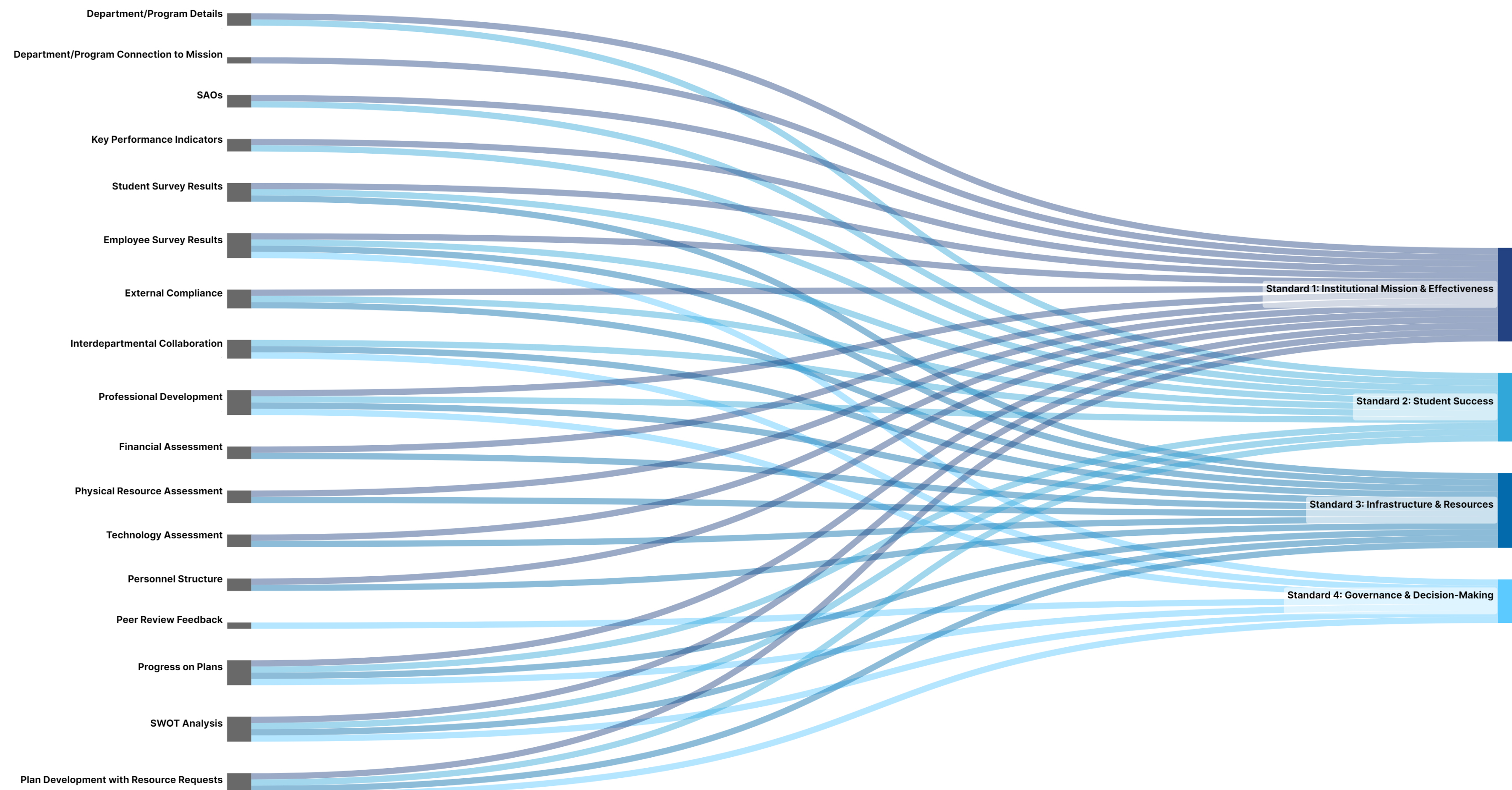
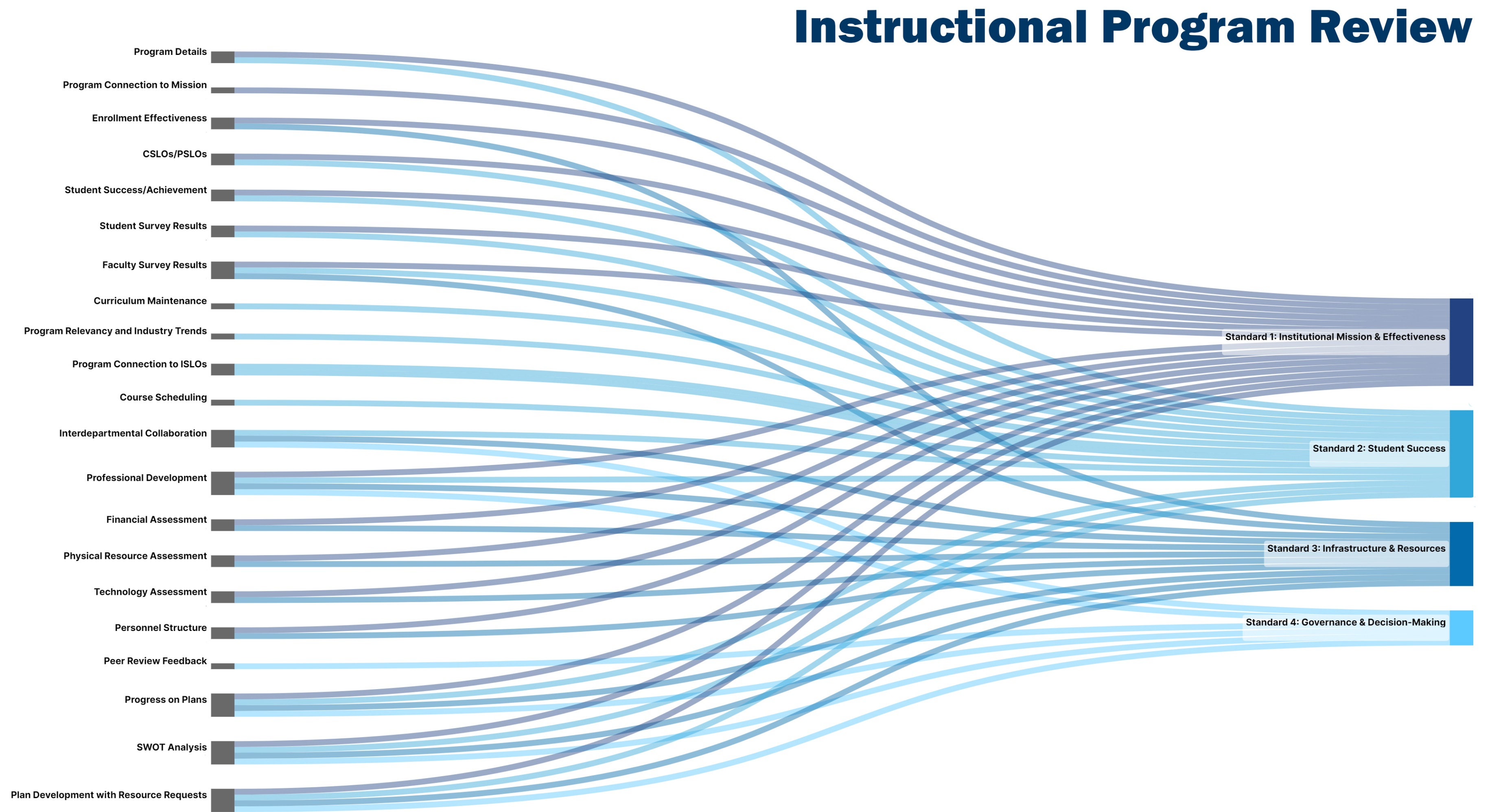




Aligning Program and Department Review with the 2024 ACCJC Accreditation Standards

The newly updated process (2023) is designed in alignment with the 2024 ACCJC Accreditation Standards. Administrative, Service, and Support Area Department Review

The Program and Department Review process at Coastline College constitutes a fundamental component of the comprehensive planning and budgeting framework. This process serves as the foundation for informed decision-making across various domains, including mission-aligned program and departmental direction and strategies with an emphasis on continual improvement related to equitable student achievement outcomes, resource effectiveness, and fostering innovative and professional development initiatives. The stakeholder inclusive review and planning process is conducted annually and integrates internal assessment of student learning by student demographic and instructional modality; enrollment effectiveness by student demographic and instructional modality; instructional and operational assessments; external data trends; and feedback from surveys to support mission-focused and data-informed strategies.
